<b>NARRATIVE:</b>			
The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the		13	of December 2016

<p>On December 13, 2016, at 9:03 p.m., the Orange County Sheriff's Office responded to 6031 Long Peak Drive, Orlando, Florida, in reference to a 911 call reporting that two people were shot. Deputy Sheriff Rachael Ward arrived on scene and located the victim, 24 year old Sade Dixon, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds to her body. Deputy Sheriff Rachael Ward performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation on Sade Dixon until Orange County Fire Rescue arrived on scene. Sade Dixon was initially lying near the front door of the residence between two concrete pillars. Lying beside Sade Dixon was her brother, 26 year old Ronald Stewart, who was also suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Personnel from Orange County Fire Rescue Station 40 responded. Paramedic Kimberly Engeman assessed Sade Dixon and pronounced her deceased at 9:16 p.m. Orange County Fire Rescue 42 also responded and transported Ronald Stewart to the Orlando Regional Medical Center (1414 Kuhl Avenue, Orlando, Florida), in critical condition. While deputies were rendering aid, Stephanie Dixon-Daniels and Dominique Daniels told deputies that Sade Dixon's boyfriend, " Marquis," just fled the scene in an older model red Buick Regal. Probable cause for Markeith Loyd was established and I authored an arrest warrant for Markeith Loyd, for the murder of Sade Dixon on December 13, 2016. On December 14, 2016, I presented an arrest warrant to the Honorable Judge Donald A. Myers, Jr, for Markeith Loyd for the First Degree Murder of Sade Dixon. After reviewing the probable cause, Judge Myers signed the arrest warrant. Since December 14, 2016, to today, January 11, 2017, Orange County Sheriff's Office has been actively searching for Markeith Loyd. During this time period it was established that Markeith Loyd's ex-girlfriend, Jameis Slaughter was actively helping Markeith Loyd evade law enforcement. On December 17, 2016, at 3:51 p.m. the Orange County Sheriff's Office responded 1035 18th Street, Orlando, Florida (Markeith Loyd's residence) in reference to a verbal altercation. The complainant, Sharon Mack reported that "Tiny" (identified as Jameis Slaughter) came to the residence to collect rent money from her because Markeith Loyd was currently wanted. On January 9, 2017, Sergeant Debra Clayton of the Orlando Police Department attempted to apprehend Markeith Loyd, at a Wal-Mart superstore when she was shot and killed by him. Markeith Loyd then fled the scene and while doing so continued to shoot at deputies during his escape. Approximately 1 1/2 hours after Sergeant Clayton was murdered, Jameis Slaughter's vehicle drove to the Wal-Mart and circled the area where Markeith Loyd escaped. Based on the fact Jamesia Slaughter has attempted to collect money for Markeith Loyd, and the driving pattern of Jamesia Slaughter since December 21, 2016, it is evident Jamesia Slaughter has been aiding and abetting Markeith Loyd from being arrested. Immediately after the murder of Sergeant Clayton, Jamesia Slaughter's phone continued to call phone number 347-282-4904 numerous times. Phone number 347-282-4904 belongs to Rahmatullah Mayan, the cousin of Zarghee Mayan. Zarghee Mayan is Markeith Loyd's old manager, at the Texas Fried Chicken, and was arrested on January 10, 2017, for aiding and abetting in Markeith Loyd's arrest. On January 10, 2017, Markeith Loyd's previous manager at the Texas Fried Chicken, Zarghee Mayan, was arrested for aiding and abetting Markeith Loyd. In a post Miranda interview with Zarghee Mayan, he confirmed that since Markeith Loyd was arrested, Lakensha Loyd came into the Texas Fried Chicken restaurant to pick up money for Markeith Loyd. Zarghee Mayan confirmed that he took \$200.00 cash from the register and gave it to Markeith Loyd. Furthermore, in the interview with Zarghee Mayan, he confirmed that "Tiny" (Jameis Slaughter) has been in communication with Markeith Loyd. On January 11, 2017, Jameis Slaughter was apprehended for assisting Markeith Loyd evade law enforcement. When she was stopped by Deputy Sheriff William Rauscher, she provided her sister's name, "Jamesia Slaughter" (twin sister). While being transported to the Orange County Sheriff's Office, Jameis Slaughter admitted she initially lied about her name to Deputy Sheriff Rauscher. Detective Robert Riley and I interviewed Jameis Slaughter, the following is a general summary of her post Miranda interview: Jameis Slaughter admitted she went to Markeith Loyd's residence on December 17, 2016, with Markeith Loyd's neice, Lakensha Smith-Loyd. She stated it was to kick out the current tenants and not to collect money. Jameis Slaughter stated she had no contact with Markeith Loyd. Further in the interview, Jameis Slaughter recanted her statement and said she has had constant communication with Markeith Loyd who called her from a blocked phone number over the last month. Jameis Slaughter initially stated she has not physically seen Markeith Loyd since October 2016. Jameis Slaughter later in the interview stated she last physically observed Markeith Loyd after he was wanted for the homicide of Sade Dixon. Jameis Slaughter stated Markeith Loyd showed up at her sister's residence unexpectedly and the two of them spoke verbally about the fact that law enforcement would have to kill him before he went back to prison. Jameis Slaughter lied several times in her involvement. The probable cause for Jameis Slaughter is outlined as follows: Sade Dixon from a gunshot wound fired by Markeith Loyd. After the homicide was committed, Jameis Slaughter went to Markeith Loyd's residence to collect money for him. Jameis Slaughter lied to law enforcement during her post Miranda interview about her communication with Markeith Loyd. Based on the above, I have probable cause to believe Jameis Slaughter was an</p>
