NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 13 of December 2016 at 21:03 at 6031 LONG PEAK DR (Zone: 13) in Orange County did

On December 13, 2016, at approximately 9:03 P.M. Orange County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to 6031 Long Peak Avenue, Orlando, Florida in reference to, a shot fired call. Upon arrival OCSO deputies located two victims with apparent gunshot wounds. The victims were later identified as Sade Lasha Dixon and Ronald Allen Stewart. Dixon was pronounced deceased on scene and Stewart was transported to Orlando Regional Medical Center with life threatening gunshot wounds. During the investigation information was obtained from eyewitnesses to the incident, stating that Markeith Demangzlo Loyd, a black male was the shooter responsible for the death and injuries to the two victims. Loyd also shot at Dixon's mother (Stephanic Dixon-Daniels) and brother (Dominique Daniels) before fleeing from the scene in his vehicle. It was also learned that Loyd and Dixon had recently lived together and Dixon was pregnant with Loyd's child; the child died as a result to Dixon's death. An arrest warrant signed by the Honorable Judge Donald A. Meyers Jr. was obtained for the arrest of Loyd. The arrest warrant obtained for Loyd was for First Degree Murder with a firearm, Killing of an unborn child by injury to mother, attempted first degree murder with a firearm, and two counts of aggravated assault with a firearm. Several attempts to locate Loyd were made yielding negative results. Agent John Podlesnik of the OCSO Fugitive Unit, made contact with several people associated with Loyd, and was not able to obtain information leading to Loyd's arrest. On December 14, 2016, Agent Podlesnik made contact with Zarghee Mayan at his place of business (New Texas Fried Chicken) located at 400 South Orange Blossom Trail, Orlando, Florida. Mayan initially denied having any contact with Loyd, but eventually admitted that he talked to him the night before, after he became aware that Loyd had killed his girlfriend [Dixon]. Mayan said that he was at work and Loyd walked in after the homicide, armed with a gun, Loyd pointed at Mayan's head and said, "drive me or I will kill you, I just did something real bad." Mayan stated that followed commands and walked to his car along with Loyd. Mayan got into the driver's seat, Loyd got in the front passenger seat of the truck and a white male by the name of James Braddy got in the back seat. Braddy is an ex-employee who used to work with Loyd at New Texas Fried Chicken. Braddy never made contact with law enforcement indicating any threats were made to his person in this encounter. Loyd ordered Mayan to drive him to a white house off of Lee Road (in Orange County, Florida), somewhere between Edgewater Road and Orange Blossom Trail. Mayan stated that he could not remember the location but might be able to take Agent Podlesnik to the general area, however he not pinpoint the exact location. Mayan never showed the Agents the location where he dropped Loyd off. \*\*NOTE: During that encounter with Mayan he did not provide any other information to Agent Podlesnik. On January 9, 2017, Detective Brian Savelli and Myself, made contact with Mayan at his residence. I explained to him that we were still trying to locate Loyd, and wanted to know if he had seen him since December 13, 2016, the night Loyd came to his business and asked him to drive him to Lee Road. Mayan responded that he had not seen him since then, but after explaining to him that it was important to find Loyd, before he hurt anyone else, he admitted he had contact with Loyd on Saturday January 7, 2017. Mayan provided a different account than he provided to Agent Podlesnik; the following is a synopsis of Mayan's statement regarding his previous contacts with Loyd since December 13, 2017. Mayan stated that on December 13, 2016, he along with a friend, drove to a trap house (slang term for a drug house) to buy cannabis. Once at the location, somewhere on Jackson Street (unknown location), he heard the rear door of his truck fly open. He then noticed Loyd enter the rear compartment of his vehicle and demand to be taken to two different locations. \*\*NOTE: Mayan said he did not see Loyd with a weapon but believed that he is dangerous, so he did what he was told. This information is different than the statement he previously provided to Agent Podlesnik. Mayan stated that Loyd pointed a gun at his head while they were at the restaurant. Furthermore, Mayan said that when he arrived at the "trap house" he saw Markeith and told him to get in the car. Loyd never made any threats towards Mayan or Braddy. Mayan said, that Loyd ordered him to take him to a residence in Richmond Heights (unknown location), he was told to walk to the house and knock on the door to see if Loyd's wife was there. Mayan walked to the front door of the residence but did not knock, he walked back to the car and told Loyd that no one answer the door. Mayan believed that if he had made contact with the ex-wife at that residence, Loyd was going to shoot her also. Mayan then drove Loyd to the next location. \*\*NOTE: this information is different than the previous statements he provided to Agent Podlesnik. Mayan said he drove from the restaurant to Lee Road while Loyd pointed at gun at him. Mayan also said that while he was driving Loyd to the two locations, Loyd told him that he shot his girlfriend and he would shot any cops if they tried to stop them. Additionally, Loyd told Mayan that the news media was providing incorrect news regarding the incident. Mayan said, Loyd shared information regarding a second gun left on scene, and the shooting happened as a result of defending himself. Mayan had knowledge the murder of Dixon had already taken place, but continued to assist Loyd by taking him to the two locations. During the trip between Jackson Street and the time Mayan dropped off Loyd at the Lee Road location, Loyd told Mayan that he would be sending

someone to collect money owed to him for previous hours worked at the restaurant. Mayan provided conflicting statements regarding Loyd's niece Lakensha Smith-Loyd, making contact with Mayan at his business to collect money. Mayan initially said that Smith-Loyd came by his restaurant two days after the murder and he gave her \$200, with the understanding she was going to give it to Loyd. Mayan then said Smith-Loyd came to his restaurant one week later, instead of the two days' time frame he previously provided; by the time Mayan provided the money to Smith-Loyd, he had knowledge that Loyd was wanted for murder. However, Mayan never advised law enforcement of the contact he had with a fugitive (Loyd). \*\* NOTE: Mayan and Smith-Loyd have worked together in the past (Mayan was Smith-Loyd's employer), so he gave her the money to give to Loyd. Mayan also said that on January 7, 2017, in the evening hours, Loyd came to the restaurant and said that he was hungry. Mayan provided Loyd with food at no charge, and never made contact with law enforcement to advise them of his contact with Loyd. During this encounter Mayan and Loyd embraced and he noticed that Loyd was armed with a gun (in his waistband), and was wearing a bullet proof vest. Loyd asked Mayan for additional money, but according to Mayan he did not give him any. Mayan said that Loyd never made any threats to him or the other employees during this encounter. Despite Mayan having knowledge that Loyd had shot and killed his girlfriend [Dixon], Mayan never contacted law enforcement to advise them of his contacts with Loyd. He then provided Loyd with additional assistance (food), aiding Loyd from avoiding apprehension. Based on the articulated facts, the inconsistent statements made by Zarghee Mayan, I have probable cause to believe that Mayan assisted Markeith Demangzlo Loyd to avoid apprehension, after Mayan became aware that Loyd had committed a murder, thus committing a violation of F.S.S. 777.03 Accessory after the fact to first degree murder with a firearm. Conclusion: 1.A murder was committed by Markeith Demangzlo Loyd. 2.After the murder was committed, Zarghee Mayan assisted Markeith Demangzlo Loyd. 3.At that time, Zarghee Mayan knew that Markeith Demangzlo Loyd had committed the murder. 4.Zarghee Mayan did so with the intent that Markeith Demangzlo Loyd avoid or escape detection, arrest, trial, or punishment.
