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**NARRATIVE:** The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 13 of December 2016 at 21:00 at 6031 LONG PEAK DR (Zone: 13) in Orange County did

On December 13, 2016, at 9:03 p.m., the Orange County Sheriff's Office responded to 6031 Long Peak Drive, Orlando, Florida, in reference to a 911 call reporting that two people were shot. Deputy Sheriff Rachael Ward arrived on scene and located the victim, 24 year old Sade Dixon, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds to her body. Deputy Sheriff Rachael Ward performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation on Sade Dixon until Orange County Fire Rescue arrived on scene. Sade Dixon was initially lying near the front door of the residence between two concrete pillars. Lying beside Sade Dixon was her brother, 26 year old Ronald Stewart, who was also suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Personnel from Orange County Fire Rescue Station 40 responded. Paramedic Kimberly Engeman assessed Sade Dixon and pronounced her deceased at 9:16 p.m. Orange County Fire Rescue 42 also responded and transported Ronald Stewart to the Orlando Regional Medical Center (1414 Kuhl Avenue, Orlando, Florida), in critical condition. While deputies were rendering aid, Stephanie Dixon-Daniels and Dominique Daniels told deputies that Sade Dixon's boyfriend, " Marquis," just fled the scene in an older model red Buick Regal. Probable cause for Markeith Loyd was established and I authored an arrest warrant for Markeith Loyd, for the murder of Sade Dixon on December 13, 2016. On December 14, 2016, I presented an arrest warrant to the Honorable Judge Donald A. Myers, Jr, for Markeith Loyd for the First Degree Murder of Sade Dixon. After reviewing the probable cause, Judge Myers signed the arrest warrant. Since December 14, 2016, to today, January 11, 2017, Orange County Sheriff's Office has been actively searching for Markeith Loyd. During the search, Markeith Loyd's niece, Lakensha Loyd, notified the Sheriff's Office and informed them she knew the whereabouts of Markeith Loyd. Lakensha Loyd asked if there was a firearm recovered at the crime scene of Sade Dixon's death, and once we answered that question she would facilitate him turning himself in because she believed he was defending himself. Several attempts have been made to talk to Lakensha Loyd and she ultimately became uncooperative with the Orange County Sheriff's Office. On January 10, 2017, Markeith Loyd's previous manager at the Texas Fried Chicken, Zarghee Mayan, was arrested for aiding and abetting Markeith Loyd. In a post Miranda interview with Zarghee Mayan, he confirmed that since Markeith Loyd was wanted, Lakensha Loyd came into the Texas Fried Chicken restaurant to pick up money for Markeith Loyd. Zaghee Mayan confirmed that he took \$200.00 cash from the register and gave it to Markeith Loyd. The probable cause for Lakensha Loyd is outlined as follows: Sade Dixon died from a gunshot wound fired by Markeith Loyd. After the homicide was committed, Lakensha Loyd, contacted the Orange County Sheriff's Office with intimate knowledge from the crime scene that was not released. Lakensha Loyd stated she would assist in the apprehension of Markeith Loyd due to the fact she knew where he was. Lakensha Loyd then stopped communication with the Orange County Sheriff's Office. Lakensha Loyd knew Markeith Loyd was wanted for the homicide, and continued to contact people on behalf of Markeith Loyd. Lakensha Loyd collected money from Zarghee Mayan in order to provide it to Markeith Loyd so that he may continue to avoid capture. Based on the above, I have probable cause to believe Lakensha Loyd was an Accessory After the Fact to Sade Dixon's Homicide, F.S.S.777.03(1).
